All the Agreements may be displayed in the classroom.

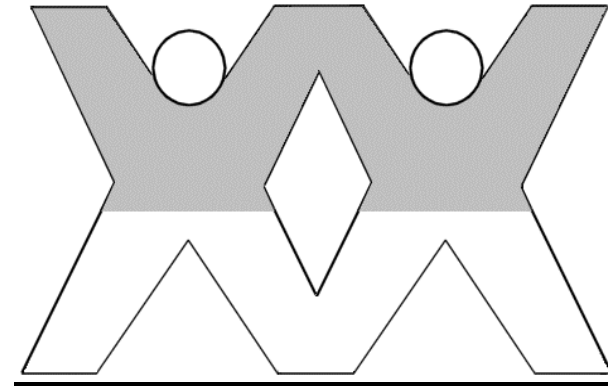
Teachers will, when appropriate, refresh the pupils (and parents) awareness of the Agreement.
